Samaritan's Purse Canada is grateful to Sprung Instant Structures Ltd. for their generosity and partnership over the years. Sprung has collaborated with Samaritan's Purse, responding to humanitarian crises with physical aid and a message of hope in time of flooding, typhoons, hurricanes, and fires.

Sprung Instant Structures Ltd. became a partner with Samaritan's Purse during the catastrophic flooding in June 2013, by hosting Samaritan Purse's Disaster Relief Unit at its headquarters to mobilize volunteers to assist 800 homeowners in Southern Alberta.

In November 2013, Typhoon Haiyan made landfall in the Philippines as a Category 5 storm displacing four million people. A donated Sprung structure served as a key warehouse and distribution center for relief supplies as Samaritan's Purse responded to this crisis.

Hurricane Irma, hit Barbuda in the Caribbean on September 7, 2017 destroying or damaging nearly every home. A 50 x 100 foot Sprung structure was generously donated and became a storage and logistics base for Samaritan's Purse for two years. The structure served the community as they completed community infrastructure, including schools, homes, public buildings and hospitals.

In 2018, the Telegraph Creek, B.C. wildfire tragically burned 125,000 hectares of land, destroyed 21 homes, and many cultural structures. ***Sprung Instant Structures Ltd.*** partnered with Samaritan's Purse to provide the Tahltan Band Council a 50 x 100 structure to house equipment and materials to aid in the recovery and long-term rebuilding in Telegraph Creek.

Together, we have met critical needs and have given people a chance to rebuild their lives here in Canada and around the world.
