**Edge School**  
Calgary, Alberta  
One - 120' wide x 229' long  
Two - 120' wide x 215' long

The Edge School is a private institution that provides high-level academic and athletic programs for students in grades 4 through 12. When leaders at the school wanted to expand the campus, they initially planned to use traditional construction for new classrooms, two NHL-sized hockey rinks and a gymnasium. But when the estimated project costs exceeded the school's budget by \$10 million, the architect and project manager approached Sprung for an alternative proposal.

Sprung provided the school with one gymnasium structure and two ice-rink structures, which were shipped, erected and completed with a net savings of \$7 million. The clear-span, fully insulated buildings are standout features on the school's campus and continue to receive high praise from visiting teams, spectators and alumni.



**LA Kings Ice at Mammoth Lakes**  
Town of Mammoth Lakes, California  
140' wide x 287.5' long

LA Kings Ice at Mammoth Lakes is a 40,000-square-foot structure that serves as a year-round indoor recreational facility for the Town of Mammoth Lakes. Known locally as the Community Recreation Center, the structure features dual layer insulation, tall peak heights, daylight panels for ample natural light and an attractive blue, grey and white exterior membrane.

Since opening, the community center has become a popular destination for locals and visitors alike. From October to April, the community center encloses an Olympic-sized ice rink (known officially as LA Kings Ice at Mammoth Lakes) where skaters can play hockey or enjoy other ice sports. Then, in the summer months, the rink is transformed into the Mammoth RecZone, a three-court gymnasium that serves as a hub for a multitude of court sports, events and activities.



**Central Park Arena**  
Collingwood, Ontario  
120' wide x 310' long

As the town of Collingwood was undergoing significant growth, local officials realized they needed additional ice surface to accommodate the athletic pursuits of their burgeoning population. They chose Sprung to provide an innovative, energy-efficient arena facility that could be used year-round.

Known as the Central Park Arena, the Sprung facility features a full-size ice surface (85' x 200') complete with dasher boards and glass, as well as spectator seating for 390 people, an upper mezzanine lounge for viewing, six dressing rooms for players, and a referee room with capacity for eight refs. The facility also houses a lounge that can be rented out for special events and presentations.
